

Our final week of rehearsal was marked with personal tragedy for one of our cast, but the way they rallied around each other and supported one another with empathy and genuine kindness made me beyond proud of them.

The show has continued to get better every time I see them perform it. I cannot wait to share this story with you, I hope it delights you as much as it does me!




Francesca,
